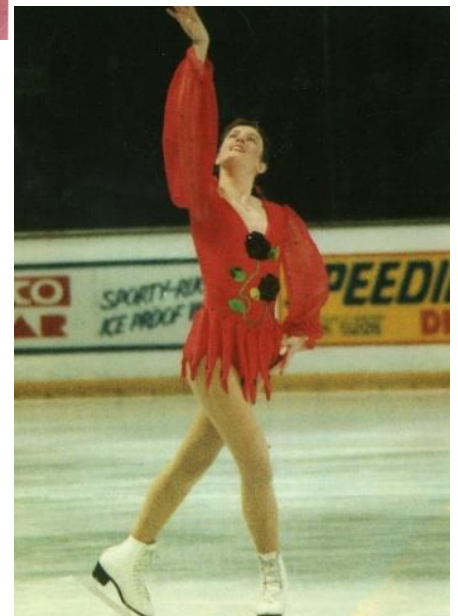
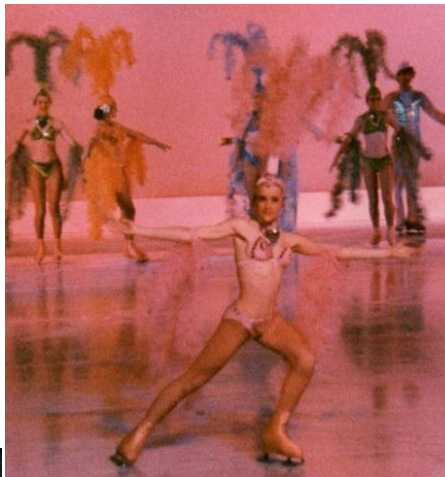
I started ice skating in South Australia in 1980 after the first Olympic sized ice rink was built.
